#### National criterion to determine when a transfer takes effect

- Departure of equipment from the exporter's territory
- Arrival of equipment in the importer's territory

Notes: 1. Germany applies the departure of equipment from the exporter's territory and arrival of equipment in the importer's territory as criteria for recording her arms transfers. 2. Germany continues: (a) to record only transfers of complete equipment, as defined in the seven categories, and (b) not to include transfers of the following items: (i) items that have been demilitarized; (ii) items transferred for destruction or disposal (especially scrapping); (iii) items serving as museum exhibits. 3. Germany submitted a paper "German Policy and Practice on Export of Conventional Weapons and Related technology" that is available at the Office for Disarmament Affairs.
